

## TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR INDIVIDUAL CONSULTANT

Hiring Office:	UNFPA Turkey Country Office, Ankara
Purpose of consultancy:	UNFPA Development Programme consists of three outcomes: (1) Sexual and Reproductive Health, (2) Gender Equality and Women's Empowerment and (3) Population Dynamics. The Programme focuses on advocacy and policy dialogue in support of government efforts to reduce disparities in the access to sexual and reproductive health and rights and gender equality, particularly for most vulnerable. UNFPA partners with state and non-state actors, United Nations organizations and donors. The programme works within a transformative development agenda that is universal, inclusive, human rights-based, integrated and anchored in the principles of equality. Programming strategies are advocacy, policy dialogue/advice, capacity building, awareness raising and generating evidence for policy development. Within this context, UNFPA Turkey has been actively involved in the prevention of child, early and forced marriages (CEFM) in Turkey within the framework of 6 <sup>th</sup> Country Programme. Two projects on prevention of child, early and forced marriage (CEFM) have been implemented under Development Programme in that regard.
	Implementing its mandate, two CEFM oriented projects under UNFPA Turkey Development Programme have been implemented and these projects aim at institutional and organizational capacity building, advocacy and policy development on CEFM, community engagement and empowerment, generating data and evidence in this field through field researches and developing inter-sectoral cooperation among relevant actors and works in close collaboration with line ministries and their provincial directorates, non-governmental organizations and universities.
	The Prevention of Child Marriages: Nevsehir Model project was implemented within this framework to support organizational capacity-building in central Nevsehir to prevent child marriages through a holistic approach and improving cooperation and coordination among the stakeholders while raising awareness across the society - through health mediators- about the health risks and consequences of child marriages. The project continues with its second phase in Nevsehir Central District, Nevsehir-Acigol District and in Van aiming at the interventions of raising awareness on the health risks and consequences of child marriages, contributing to the establishment of a more effective intervention mechanism through capacity building for health mediators, healthcare service providers and other service providers, building partnership among service providers, public administrators, opinion leaders and NGOs, promoting all efforts and activities complement the existing action plans, raising awareness across the society through community- based efforts involving health mediators.
	To strengthen and support the field operations of the project, UNFPA will be hiring a consultant to be deployed to Nevsehir which is one of the project provinces.
Scope of work: (Description of services, activities, or outputs)	<ul> <li>The consultant will be responsible for:</li> <li>Mapping of local services, reporting mechanisms and referral mechanisms for prevention of child, early and forced marriage provided by government and national/international NGOs.</li> <li>Communication with NGOs and local partners (Nevşehir Province Governorate, Provincial Health Directorates, Provincial Directorates of Family and Social Policies, Nevsehir and Acıgol Municipalities etc.) for better coordination to facilitate implementation of project activities and to organize need assessment meeting(s) to clarify the neighbourhoods where the fieldwork will be conducted.</li> </ul>



	<ul> <li>Monitoring of health mediators mechanism, supervising household visits and neighbourhood activities conducted by health mediators, identifying bottlenecks and deviation from standards.</li> <li>Supporting health mediators in data collection and in filling up household visit forms.</li> <li>Attending local coordination meetings as UNFPA, Prevention of CEFM Ankara Team backup, reporting on developments to Ankara office.</li> <li>Attending capacity building training towards governmental and non-governmental organizations and towards health mediators, refresher and reinforcement training towards former health mediators.</li> <li>Giving support to facilitate focus group meetings with, religious officials, school counsellors, mukhtars, healthcare professionals (particularly midwives) in Nevsehir Acigol District.</li> <li>Giving support to dissemination of project promotion materials among NGOs, local partners, municipalities, governorates etc.</li> <li>Facilitating referrals and collaboration between relevant institutions and key actors at the provincial level.</li> <li>Supporting logistics of the Prevention of CEFM Team visits to the covered district(s).</li> <li>Making travel arrangements related to Prevention of Child Marriages – 2 project and other UNFPA programme activities.</li> <li>Organizing local project events (meetings, workshops, events, seminars, training) in Nevsehir (Central District and Acigol District) as requested by the CEFM Project Manager. Conducting trainings if requested by team.</li> <li>Weekly reporting on activities including visits to local authorities, and partners.</li> <li>Performing any other duties, as may be required by UNFPA.</li> </ul>
